The Trenton William Stewart Legacy Scholarship will be awarded to 4 outstanding graduating seniors who attend St. Johns, Duval, or Clay County Public Schools. A priority may be given to those who have a financial need and plan to play a collegiate sport.

Trenton, a graduate of Creekside High School and student athlete at Stetson University, was the epitome of what it takes to be an athlete at the high school and college levels. He had an unwavering commitment to “not quitting” and was fully dedicated to being the best version himself, on and off the field. Trenton was driven, dedicated, and had an absolute love for football and sports. The recipients of The Trenton Stewart Legacy Scholarships should embody the characteristics that made Trenton the young man he was. Trenton’s life was cut short on May 9th, 2023 by a reckless criminal driving under the influence of multiple substances; therefore, the recipient will also need to be dedicated to living a healthy and drug free life.

There will be four (4) \$1,000 scholarships available in 2026.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must maintain an average cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher. Those with financial need are always a priority of The Trenton Stewart Foundation but not a requirement.
- Applicants must embody the following characteristics:
 - Drive and Perseverance
 - Leadership within their high school and community
 - A strong work-ethic
 - A commitment to living a healthy and drugfree lifestyle
 - A commitment to driving sober and ensuring those they are with also drive sober or have a safe ride home
